- Ongoing development and training

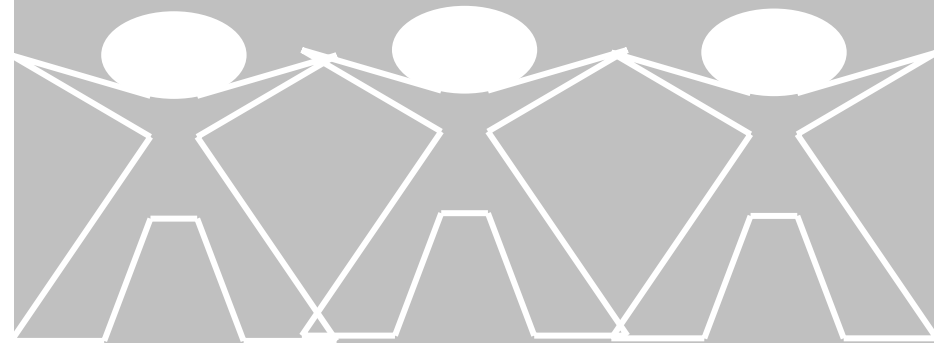

We ask that you:

- Are prepared to be available at least two hours a week for six months (*some volunteers do more than this but all volunteers need to be careful not to over commit themselves*).
- Declare **ALL** previous convictions AND cautions. Previous offences are not necessarily a barrier.

Due to the nature of the work we take up references and undertake Criminal Record Bureau and Child Protection Checks.

If you have had current or recent contact with an offender, you should also tell us as this may affect where you should be placed within the service.
